My Dear Wife,

I received a letter from you and Jake Walker last night staten (how) you was; and (I am) glad to hear from you. I am well and hope this may find you the same. I got some money last night and send you \$40 dollars by Express to Canajoharie and you must go and git it. I sent it in your name. Git your Pap to take you to Canajoharie and git it; you will have to go and git it because it is sent in your name.

We leave this place today, where to, I can't say. I want you to write just as soon as you git your money so I will know whether you git it or not. I must close now. Good bye.
