Declaration for Sworned Pensioner
Original

STATE OF New York
New York COUNTY. } ss.

On this 31st day of January, 1874, before me, a Deputy Clerk
a Justice of Peace in and for the County and State above-named, personally appeared,
Simcon Sammons - a resident of Broda Montgomery County in the
State of New York - aged 62 years, who being duly sworn according to law, declares
that he is the identical Simcon Sammons who was a Captain of Company
in the 115th Regiment of New York Volunteers, in the war of 1861 for the
suppression of the Rebellion.

That he volunteered in Managers Camp in the State of New York -
on or about the 30th day of August, 1862 for the term of Three years
and was honorably discharged at Broda N. Y. on the 19th day of November, 1864

That while in said service in the line of his duty at Alustee in the State of
Florida, on the 20th day of February, 1864

he received a gunshot wound in right foot in action, and
at same date and place he received a severe contusion of the
head slightly cracking the skull, by a fall from his horse -
at Cemetery Hill, Va. on the 30th day of July, 1864. he was wounded
in left hip by a gunshot, and when ordered to fall back with
his command by Genl Turner, he was twice prostrated by the
enemys shot and shell one of them casting several hundred feet
of earth upon him and one passing near his right shoulder, leaving the
wound on the ground indelible and from injuries thus received his
right shoulder has never recovered its usual strength.

He makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the Invalid Pension Roll of the United States, by
reason of the disability above stated; and hereby constitutes and appoints E. B. JACKSON, of Philadelphia his
Attorney, to prosecute this claim and procure a Pension Certificate.

in the war of the rebellion who died in the town of Mohawk, Montgomery Co. N.Y. of wounds [State nature of wounds and all circumstances attending them, or the disease and manner in which it was incurred, in either case showing soldier's death to have been the consequence.] of right foot & left hip which was followed by severe erysipelas

as the result of gunshot wounds & was the direct cause of his death, Thompson Burton M on the 1st day of January, A. D. 1884

who was at the time of his death the rank of Burtonville, Jan 1st 1884 ["In the service aforesaid," or otherwise.]

that she was married under the name of Barbara Grosse to said Simcon Simmons on the 24th day of December, A. D. 1835 by Rev. Abram Van Horne at Johannston N.Y. there being no legal barrier to such marriage; that neither she nor her husband had been previously married [If either have been previously married
